Club Code of Conduct

Obligations towards the game

A player should:

- *Make every effort to develop their own sporting abilities, in terms of skill, technique, tactics and stamina.*
- *Give maximum effort and strive for the best possible performances during a game, even if her team is in a position where the desired result has already been achieved.*
- *Set a positive example for others, particularly young players and supporters.*
- *Avoid all forms of gamesmanship and time-wasting.*
- *Always have regard to the best of interests of the game, including where publicly expressing an opinion on the game and any particular aspect of it, including others involved in the game.*
- *Not use inappropriate language.*

Obligations towards one's own team

A player should:

- *Make every effort consistent with Fair Play and the Laws of the Game to help her own team win.*
- *Resist any influence which might, or might be seen to, bring into question his commitment to the team winning.*

Respect for the Laws of the Game and competition rules

A player should:

- *Know and abide by the Laws, rules and the spirit of the game, and the competition rules.*
- *Accept success and failure, victory and defeat, equally.*
- *Resist any temptation to take banned substances or use banned techniques.*

Respect towards Opponents

A player should:

- *Treat opponents with due respect at all times, irrespective of the result of the game.*
- *Safeguard the physical fitness of opponents, avoid violence and rough play, and aid injured opponents.*

Respect towards the Match Officials

A player should:

- *Accept the decision of the Match Official without protest.*
- *Avoid words or actions which may mislead a Match Official*
- *Show due respect towards Match Officials*

Respect towards Team Officials

A player should:

- *Abide by the instructions of their Coach and Team Officials, provided they do not contradict the spirit of this Code.*
- *Show due respect towards the Team Officials of the opposition.*

Obligations towards the Supporters

A player should:

- *Show due respect to the interests of supporters*

Match Day Protocol

1. Players are asked to prepare themselves in the build-up to the match in the best way possible by
 - 1.1. Attending all training sessions where possible (informing coaching staff of any possible absences or late arrivals)
 - 1.2. Staying informed about the match itself
 - 1.3. Preparing correctly the night before
 - 1.4. Ensuring that they arrive at the match venue in the best possible condition, both mentally and physically.
2. If a player believes they will either arrive late, or be absent from the match, they are to inform the Club Management at the earliest possible convenience. Failure to do so without good reason may be subject to a club warning or fine.
3. When fixtures are published by the League or relevant Competition Organisers, the following information will be announced by the Fixtures Secretary:
 - *Opposition*
 - *Venue*
 - *Competition*
 - *Date*
 - *Kick off time*
 - *Meet-up time and venue (if away)*
 - *Special instructions (if a replay or extra-time/penalties applies as a result of tied scores, extreme weather forecasts, i.e. extreme cold, heat or rain which may affect the match status, playing conditions or pose a risk to player's health).*

This information will be announced on the club's website, on the club's FaceBook page and by SMS/e-mail.

4. Match day procedure

- 4.1. **1 hour 15 minutes before kickoff:** *Players are to be present at the ground. Players arriving after this point without good reason or without having notified the Club Management, will be dropped to the substitutes' bench.*
- 4.2. **1 hour:** *The team sheets are handed in. Players arriving after this point without having notified the Club Management beforehand WILL NOT be permitted to participate.*
- 4.3. **40 minutes:** *Players are to be changed into match or warm-up kit, in order for the coaching staff to deliver their briefing.*
- 4.4. **5 minutes:** *Players to be presented to match officials for jewellery / boot inspection and RESPECT handshake.*
- 4.5. **Away games**
 - 4.5.1. *If players are travelling to the away venue themselves, they must advise the Club Management at the earliest possible opportunity.*
 - 4.5.2. *Players needing to get something to eat or drink are asked to arrive in advance of the meet-up time for away fixtures.*
 - 4.5.3. *Players arriving more than 10 minutes after the meet-up time for away fixtures may be subject to a warning/fine to be determined by the club committee.*
- 4.6. *Where matches are postponed, the fixtures secretary will notify all playing and coaching staff by all the above mentioned methods (see fixture information) at the earliest convenience. Players are required to then reply by SMS or e-mail to confirm receipt of the postponement.*

Summary & Agreement of conditions

This registration will run from the date below to 31 May 2011 inclusive.

- All the information I have provided is true and accurate.
- I know of no reason why I may not be permitted to register for the Club as of the date below.
- I am forbidden to register for any other club, save for prior written permission from the club secretary.
- I understand I must pay all monies where required, including fees, club fines and fines imposed by County FA/The FA.
- If I wish to cancel this registration, I must provide written notification to the club secretary, giving no less than one week's notice, and that I must have paid all outstanding club fees before I will be released.
- If I play for a new club whilst either registered for Aldershot Town Ladies & Girls FC, or having failed to pay all fees by 1 July 2011, my new club, both clubs' County Football Associations and the Football Association will be notified and **a request for me to be suspended from playing until all monies are paid may be served.**
This is to ensure the financial survival of the club where in the past, players have transferred from one club to the other without paying due monies.
- I will not be permitted to renew my registration with Aldershot Town Ladies & Girls FC for the 2011/2012 season until I have paid all required monies by 1 July 2011.
Again this is a rule resulting from past players not paying for one seasons' fees and expecting to play in another.
- If I miss consecutive training sessions/matches as a **genuine** result of holidays, work, studies or injury, then these fees **may** (subject to agreement by the club committee) either be reimbursed or waived, depending on if they have been paid or not.
If matches are postponed, fees will only be reimbursed/waived if they are not rescheduled or played.
Fees will NOT be reimbursed if players miss matches as a result of suspensions imposed by the Club, League, County FA or The FA.
- I agree to abide by the FA's Respect Code of Conduct for Players
- I agree to abide by the Club's Code of Conduct for Players
- I agree to abide by the Match Day Protocol
- I understand and agree to all of the above conditions of this registration, that I sign this agreement of my own free will, and that any amendments to my registration may not be made without my express permission.
